3. Location and directions

Recreatiegebied Vlietland

Windsurfvereniging Vlietland Rietpolderweg 7 2266 BM Leidschendam



3.1 Accessibility of the Venue

The competition venue is located on the field/beach in front of the Windsurfvereniging Vlietland.

Please note that public transport connections to Vlietland are relatively limited. For planning your journey by train, bus, or other public transport, we recommend using www.9292.nl.

For those arriving by car, access to the venue is straightforward. Spacious parking areas are available directly adjacent to the competition site.







4. Weather

Forecast for Saturday 13e September at Vlietland (based on the forecast of Wednesday, 10 September)

For Saturday, 13 September, the weather at the Vlietland recreation area is expected to be cool with occasional showers. Temperatures will reach a high of around 17 °C and a low of approximately 10 °C in the evening.

The wind is forecast to be moderate from the southwest at around 3–4 Bft (10–15 km/h). Please note that this inland forecast differs significantly from the coastal forecast, where stronger winds and higher waves are expected.

Recommendations

- Be prepared for changeable weather with intermittent rain showers.
- Wear layers to stay warm and comfortable; a light rain jacket or windbreaker is strongly advised.
- Bring water-resistant footwear suitable for wet grass or sand.
- Have an extra warm layer (sweater or fleece) for the morning and evening when it will feel noticeably cooler.

5. Facilities

In the building of the Windsurfvereniging, basic changing rooms are available for athletes.

Roeivereniging Rijnland, located approximately 5 minutes walking distance from the competition venue, provides additional facilities. Before the races, ergometers in the gym can be used for warming up. In the afternoon, after the competition, showers will be available at Roeivereniging Rijnland.

6. Time registration

Time registration will be done in cooperation with the jury and results will be available at the jury tent at the beach. Also, the results can be found on the website: https://regatta.time-team.nl/rotterdambeachsprints/2025/results/races.php

7. Safety and Health of Rowers (Coastal Regulation 5, Rule14)

Each rower at the IRBS shall ensure that:

- They have a state of health and fitness which allows them to compete at a level commensurate with the competition level of the particular event
- They have a basic swimming ability, including being able to swim 50m and keep their head above water unassisted for minimal ten minutes







8. Boat Handlers

- The role of the boat handler is to support the departure and arrival of the crew / athlete from and to the beach by handling the boat to reduce the risk of damage or injury.
- When the boat returns to the beach the boat handlers may "catch" the boat to slow its
 progress when it reaches the beach and a crew / athlete member disembarks to run
 to the finish line.
- After the crew / athlete member disembarks to run, the boat handlers are responsible
 for the swift removal of the boat from the water. Once the runner has exited the water,
 boat handlers shall stay with the boat and not assist or run with the crew / athlete
 member to the finish line.
- The boat handlers shall comply with any instructions of the race officials and shall at all times be subject to the Rules of Racing.
- The role of the boat handler is to support the safe entry and exit of the boat and not to run with the athletes.
- The boat handlers are expected o be close to the boats and have their hands on the boat quickly to avoid injuries and any damages on the boats.
- Crew / athlete penalty for wrong boat handling: the jury may impose an appropriate penalty for wrong boat handling.
- Please make sure that when you take your own handlers, you have 2 boat handlers

9. Table of Penalties and Sanctions for Infractions:

- Crew / athletes must compete with the standard rigging as specified in the Competition Notice. In case crew / athletes are found having modified the setting of the boats in violation of the standard, the jury may impose an appropriate penalty for wrong boat handling.
- A crew that does not round all the buoys correctly Did Not Finish the race (DNF) and is excluded (no time penalties).
- A runner not passing on the correct side of the flag shall be awarded a sanction of a Time Penalty of 10 seconds.
- Interference to its opponents. It is each crew / athlete's / athlete responsibility to remain in their proper course and their water and to not cause interference to other crew / athletes. Interference: penalty is EXC, a time penalty of 10 seconds or any appropriate penalty as determined by the jury.







10. Processional Time Trial:

- All athletes must report to the Call Room table 10min before the time of their time trial.
- There will be 4 boats (so crew / athlete 5 will use boat 1, crew / athlete 6 will use boat 2 etc..).
- The boat handlers MUST receive the boat at the finish and move it to the correct parking spot. (boat 1 to parking spot 1)
- Teams must ensure they check the boat for damage before they race.
- Start flag and horn / button with no sound.


10.1 Course:

Run of 30m – 60m depending on tide / Row of 525m / Run of 30m

- One of the crew will run from the start line, to the boat on the water in Lane 2 and enter the boat around the flag.
- The crew / athlete will race 250m out to the end buoy, passing outside the 1st buoy slalom inside the 2nd buoy. (note: depending on weather conditions OC can decide that 1st and 2nd bouy can be cancelled)
- At the end of Lane 2, the crew will turn 90 degrees, passing outside the buoy, and row 25-30m to the Lane 1 end buoy and turn 90 degrees.
- At the Lane 1 end buoy, the crew will again turn 90 degrees toward the beach, passing outside the buoy.
- The crew / athlete will row 250m straight back to shore in Lane 1, keeping outside of all of the buoys.
- Once on the shore one of the crew will run around the outside of the Lane Flag, up the beach to the finish line.

Boat Preparation Crews in the time trial must report to Control Commission (CC) to receive their boat, immediately when it comes off the water. Each crew and their boat handlers will have 3-4 minutes to prepare their boat and move it to the ready position.

10.2. Pre start Timing & Commands Time-Trails:

• 3 min before start:

All boats on numbered trestles (1-4), Crew / athletes (1-4) & their boat handlers standing by their boats.

• Crew / athletes 5,6,7 etc. should be waiting to report to Control Committee (CC) with their boat handlers.

CC will inform each crew / athlete which empty trestle they should go to. It is each crew / athlete's responsibility to be ready.

- Once ready Boat 1 should go to the 'Ready' position, here they are under the control
 of the Starter.
- CC will take care that the boats are brought to the Ready Position as soon as it is free

• 30's before start:

Starter will instruct 'Crew / athlete 1 take your boat to the water'. Runner must be behind the start line.

• Start time 1: (0 sec)

Starter will say: 'Attention' 'GO!'


• 120 sec after first start:

Starter will instruct: 'Crew 2 take your boat to the water' Runner must be behind the start line.

• Start time 2: (180 sec)

Starter will say: 'Attention' 'GO!'

- This procedure will be repeated until all crew / athletes have raced. Crew / Athlete 5 will use Boat 1, Crew / Athlete 6 will use Boat 2, Crew / athlete 7 will use Boat 3 etc...
 If a boat is damaged or unable to continue for any reason, Crew / Athlete will be instructed to take the next available boat.
- Start every 3min










11. Finals

- Ideally, we have 16 positions for the knock-out phase, where we start with #16 in the time-trial against #1, and so on: 8 races in the first round. Then 4 in the second round, 2 in the third round. The fourth round has an B final for #3 and #4 and an A final for #1 and #2.
- If we have less than 16 but more than 8 athletes in the time-trials, we will directly place the top athletes to the second round of the finals. For example, 13 athletes in the time-trials means that we will place numbers #1-3 directly, and numbers #4-13 will compete in 5 races for a position in the second round (#13 of the time-trials against #4, and so on).
- All crew's / athletes must report to the Call Room table10 min before the time of their race.
- There will be 4 boats
- Athletes are allowed a maximum of 3 minutes to adjust the foot stretcher in their assigned boat. Adjustments may only be made while the boat is positioned on the tires.
- Teams must ensure they check the boat for damage before they race.
- Start flag and horn / button with no sound.

11.2 Start procedure

- The boats shall be in the water held by boathandlers and crew member (C2x)).
- There shall be up to two boat handlers per boat.
- Second rowers must not start boarding their boat until after the start signal is given (C2x).

3 Minutes before the start

- All crews in the Start area
- The Starter may penalise crews who are late to the start

2.45 minutes to 1.45 minutes before the start *

- Crews are introduced to the spectators by the Announcer
- Crews than move to their start positions (on the Start Line or at the boat)
 * only for Semi-Finals & Finals
- 1 minute before the start
- The Announcer shall say 'Put the boats in the water' all crews, handlers and boats must be in position
- 30 seconds before the start
- The starter shall say 'get ready' then the Starter could start the race at any time
- The start
- The Starter shall say 'Attention' and shall raise a red flag. After a pause he shall drop the flag down, and hooter.

11.3 The Race, Turning around the Buoys

- OK to touch the turning buoys with boat or oars, but the hull of the boat must pass around the correct side of the buoy.
- Incorrect rounding or failure to round all buoys DNF
- Return flag failure to run around 10 second penalty

11.4 The Finish

- The finish of the race for each crew shall be the moment their crew member reaches the finish point and presses the red button.
- If you miss the button, you must still press it to finish the race.









15 Information & communication

A message will be sent to all Team Managers inviting them to join a Team Managers' WhatsApp group. This group will be used to share all relevant information, notify you of any potential program changes, and provide the final Captains' Manual, which will be shared on Wednesday, September 10th
